MONTHLY MEETINGS

Media Coalition members and contributors meet monthly in New York, in person and by telephone. The meetings are an opportunity for members to identify looming censorship threats, assess legislative and legal responses to those threats, and decide on courses of action.

Comprehensive meeting packets containing legal summaries, a detailed legislative review, media clips, and written summaries of Media Coalition activities are distributed by mail and email prior to the meeting. Minutes of the meeting are distributed later.

NETWORKING

The Media Coalition brings together some of the leading First Amendment advocates for media issues. The ability to interact and draw on the experience of others is one of the greatest benefits of the Media Coalition.

EVERY DAY RESOURCES

- **Listserve:** The Media Coalition uses a listserv to distribute timely alerts on pertinent issues. Analyses of legal decisions, alerts on legislative action, judicial opinions, and notable briefs are distributed through the listserv.
- **Website:** mediacoalition.org provides access to an extensive archive of legal decisions, legislative summaries, and position statements.
- **Library:** In addition to the materials available on the website, The Media Coalition maintains a library of books, reports, legal decisions and legislative summaries of interest to its members.
